

Health Guarantee and Puppy Contract

Terms and Conditions of Puppy Contract

The Breeder Agrees:

That this puppy is in good health at the time of sale. The buyer will have 72 hours after receiving their puppy in which to have the puppy examined by their own veterinarian. If the puppy is found to be ill by a licensed veterinarian and is to be returned due to illness, a letter from the veterinarian is required. This includes death or illness from any health condition deemed to be present prior to the leaving the seller's premises (White River Kennel). Buyer shall assume any expenses associated with returning the puppy to the seller. The seller will, at the seller's discretion, refund the purchase price, return the dog to the buyer in healthy condition, OR exchange the dog for another dog of equal value. At no time and under no circumstances will the Breeder be responsible for any veterinary expenses incurred by the buyer.

This animal is warranted against GENETIC Defects for 3 years from the date of purchase. Should this puppy be determined to be suffering from a genetic defect deemed to be hereditary (within 3 years from the date of purchase), White River Kennel will replace the puppy with one of the same value when one is available after notification and written verification has been furnished to the Breeder by TWO independent veterinarians. The breeder will not be responsible for any veterinary costs at any time. We cannot guarantee that your puppy will never develop any health problems, just as a pediatrician cannot guarantee that a child will never develop any health problems in the future. Some things are just not able to be predicted. We offer 30 days of free AKC puppy insurance and suggest the buyer keep the insurance active for their puppy in the future. Our parents are free of diseases, disorders, and health problems; otherwise we would not breed them. That means our puppies are less likely to develop problems. If anything does occur, you are required to inform us so we can evaluate the parents and the other puppies from that litter in an attempt to determine the cause of the ailment and to eliminate the issue from our breeding program.

Breeder does NOT GUARANTEE against COCCIDIA or GHIRDIA (typically dormant single celled parasites common in puppies) or for final adult weight, color, breeding ability, show potential or against overbites, under bites, patella issues, hernias, trachea issues or for undescended testicles.

Seller agrees to notify buyer if they or the vet discover any of the above problems prior to sale. When paying your deposit you agree that you have read and understand what BREEDER does and does not guarantee for.

The Breeder states that the puppy has received the following vaccinations –1 NEOPAR (Parvo Only vaccine at 5-6 weeks old) and a 5-way Vaccine for **Distemper, Parainfluenza, Adenovirus Type 2, Canine Hepatitis and Parvovirus** (at 7-9 weeks old). Your Veterinarian will inform you of when a booster is due, your puppy will need 2-3 more puppy vaccines and rabies at 16 weeks old and then yearly boosters. We worm puppies with NEMEX and Panacure at 4 and 6 weeks old. Please see your puppy's health record for details on the health care your puppy has received while with the breeder.

The Buyer Agrees:

That this puppy will be given adequate and proper shelter and housed securely indoors. This dog shall not be neglected, allowed to roam free, or be mistreated in any manner. The puppy shall receive proper veterinary care throughout its life, receiving annual inoculations and placed on a heartworm preventative. The puppy shall receive proper nutrition and care shall be taken to maintain its proper weight. Buyer agrees to give the dog proper training and socialization. Buyer agrees to never sell or surrender this dog into a dog fighting institution, testing center or shelter.

The Buyer agrees to finish all puppy vaccines before taking their puppy out in public, letting their puppy on public sidewalks and grasses, or letting their puppy be touched by people outside of the family. This reduces the chance of your puppy picking up a communicable disease such as parvo.

The Buyer agrees to return the dog to the Breeder if for any reason the Buyer no longer wants to or is unable to keep the dog. Breeder agrees to either assist Buyer in finding another suitable home where the dog will receive proper care or to accept the dog back at any time with no refund to be given to the Buyer as Breeder would accept responsibility for the dog and will be responsible for the future cost of care including vet care and training. The Buyer will notify the Breeder of any changes of address and will maintain contact with the seller throughout the life of this dog. The Buyer will register the puppy with the AKC prior to 1 year of age.

Buyer agrees not to breed this dog. This puppy will be registered with limited registration and spaying/neutering is required by 1 year of age. If prior to the dog's first birthday, the Buyer feels that this puppy is indeed show or breeding quality and wishes to show or breed this puppy, and the Breeder agrees, the limited registration can be lifted by the breeder for an additional fee to be determined at a later date by the breeder. Limited registration in no way prevents this puppy from participating in any AKC event except for the conformation ring. If the Buyer wants to compete in a event that or shows reason other than for breeding purposes at the sellers desecration can invoice the buyer for an additional fee and additional contract addendum that must be signed separate from this contract.

If agreed upon prior to purchase and delivery of the puppy the Buyer can purchased full registration (only offered with Silver Weimaraners at this time) with breeding rights at an additional cost of \$400. With full registration the puppy is eligible for AKC sanctioned events including the conformation ring and all Breeding rights are included. We do not offer breeding rights on our Blue Weimaraner puppies or Our Vizsla puppies.

No guarantees or warranties, expressed or implied, are given by White River Kennels (Robert and Terry Young), the Breeder, except those stated herein. Breeder warrants and agrees that they are the lawful owner of this puppy and are alone responsible for entering into this contract with the Buyer.

When paying your puppy deposit, both parties, Breeder and Buyer, agree to abide by the contents of this contract.

Puppy deposits are non-refundable. Your deposit holds your puppy and is a commitment to purchase your new family member.
